



Sporting Shooters' Association of Australia (Tasmania) Oakdale Pistol Club Inc.



The S.S.A.A. Oakdale Pistol Club Inc. range is located off the Flagstaff Gully Link Road in Warrane. The range is primarily for handguns but has been approved for limited longarm events. No centrefire rifles are allowed except for lever actions in calibres approved for Cowboy Lever Action Silhouette & Single Action Shooting events. **No bolt action centrefire rifles are allowed !!**

Handgun events are;

- 1. Handgun Metallic Silhouette (I.H.M.S.A.)**
 - i) Rimfire Silhouette*
 - ii) Centrefire Silhouette*
 - iii) Field Pistol Silhouette*
- 2. IPSC Style Practical Pistol**
- 3. Service Pistol & ISSF Slowfire**
- 4. NRA Style Action Pistol**

Longarm events are;

- 1. Cowboy Lever Action Silhouette**
 - i) Rimfire Lever Action Silhouette*
 - ii) Pistol Calibre Lever Action Silhouette (100 metres)*
 - iii) Centrefire Lever Action Silhouette (200 metres)*
- 2. Rimfire Metallic Silhouette Rifle**
- 3. IPSC Style Practical Rimfire Rifle & Practical Shotgun**
- 4. Single Action Shooting – Cowboy Action Match**

To be eligible to join the S.S.A.A. Oakdale Pistol Club Inc. you must be a member of the **Sporting Shooters Association of Australia**. If you are not already a member an application form is attached to the Oakdale application. Your nominated home branch should be **T01 Oakdale** or else you can only become an associate member.

How To Join The Club

1. There are legal obligations which must be met if you wish to shoot at and/or join the S.S.A.A. Oakdale Pistol Club:

- **You must have a firearms licence with the appropriate category and reason endorsement.**

If this is the case, you can shoot on the Oakdale range as a visitor and pay the appropriate visitor range fee, or you can apply to become a member of our club. You must be able to produce your licence upon request by an Oakdale official.

or

- **You must apply for an Exemption from the Commissioner of Police.**

If you don't have a firearms licence or the correct endorsements, you must fill in an **Application For An Exemption**. This application will allow a one-time only shooting attendance at our club. If you decide to continue with the sport and want to become a member, the application must be sent to Firearms Services for a character check to see if you are suitable for an exemption. If your application is successful, you and the club will be notified and you can continue to shoot at Oakdale until membership and a firearms licence is granted. The exemption is valid for six (6) months, unless it's revoked by the Commissioner of Police, and will only allow you to shoot at the club it was issued to.

2. After you receive your exemption, complete the SSAA Oakdale Application for Membership.
3. Attach two reference letters, clearly stating the name and address of the referee.
4. Include a non-refundable deposit of **\$10.00**. This will be deducted from your joining fee.
5. Hand it to a committee member or mail it to;

A three month probation and a minimum of 5 attendances for coaching / training is mandatory and will begin upon the committees receipt of your application. During this time it is essential for you to attend the range as much as possible to familiarise yourself with range commands, gun handling techniques and safety requirements. This is also when you have your attendance form signed & dated by the pistol captain/s and insert your S.S.A.A. membership number.

When your probation is completed satisfactorily your application, references and attendance form/s, will be tabled at the next committee meeting for approval. If the application is successful the club will forward the following account;

When payment is received, you become a financial member and firearms services are notified of your membership status. You will receive a letter, stating your acceptance into the club, a range pass and a copy of the club policy & safety rules. Members must attend a minimum of **four (4)** rostered shooting fixtures per calendar year in order to retain their membership.
